Summary

The Sixth European Community Action Plan in environmental matters makes specific reference to one of the main issues throughout Europe: integrated coastal area management. The special attraction of these areas as places where many and varied human activities take place means that there are frequent clashes between the demands to conserve the natural values of coastal areas. To face this problem, the various Balearic public bodies have created a wide range of laws and regulations responding precisely to the need to ensure a balance between the environment and the development of human activity.

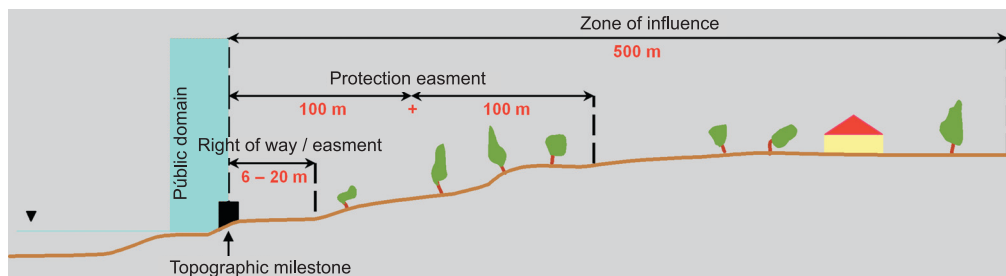
Actions

-Analyse in detail the body of laws and regulations affecting the coastal environment, dividing them into territories where they apply, to offer a clear and systematic study of the various and concurrent laws on the Balearic coast.

-Fill the void supposed by the inexistence of a systematic presentation of laws applicable in the Balearic coast.

-Respond to the need for legal practitioners (and the population in general) to have access to a legal database allowing them to know about and manage quickly and easily the laws and regulations applicable in coastal areas.

-Generate a database working as an agile tool for various public and private bodies working in coastal areas and, at the same time, as an accessible source of knowledge for people in general interested in the area.

Administration

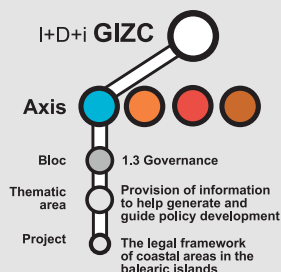
